

SAFETY COURSES

SAFETY SIGNS, TAGS and LABELS (SF14A)

OBJECTIVE:

This course explains in simple-to-understand terms the meaning of colors, symbols, words, and numbers used in safety signs, tags, and labels. It explains the 3 colors identifying the levels of safety; presents the safety signal words; explains the differences between HazCOM standards labels and DOT labels; Covers ANSI label requirements; presents the NFPA Hazard warnings system requirement; and details special packing instructions for hazardous materials.
